3. ELIGIBILITY & SECTIONS

3.1 Eligibility for a section will be determined using a player’s **Chess SA (Main)** rating or their **FIDE (Standard)** rating.

3.1.1 Players must use the **higher** of the two ratings to determine their eligibility for a specific section

3.2 Players holding the title of GM, IM, WGM and WIM are eligible for **FREE** entry. Use the discount code “**TITLED**” in the discount code field when registering on the ChessWorks platform.

3.3 Players with Disabilities (PWD)

3.3.1 Criteria: **Legally** disabled players

3.3.2 There is no dedicated section for PWDs. They will compete in their appropriate sections according to the section criteria stated above.

3.3.3 PWDs must indicate their status on the registration form when signing up on the ChessWorks platform so that they can be correctly categorised and considered eligible for prize money.

3.4 Refund Policy

3.4.1 A R200 admin fee applies before closing date. No refunds after closing date.

4.1 Players finishing on the same score will share the prize money.

4.2 PWDs: Best PWD per section – R3 000. Awarded only if the player scores at least 50% of the possible score and is not already in a main prize position. One prize per player.

4.3 Prize money will be transferred within 14 days of the conclusion of the tournament.

8. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

8.1 Time Controls

8.1.1 Prestige, Ladies, B Section and C Section: 90 minutes each for the entire game with an increment of 30 seconds per move.

8.1.2 Juniors and Seniors: 60 minutes each for the entire game with an increment of 2 seconds per move.

8.1.3 Blitz Tournament: 3 minutes each for the entire game with an increment of 2 seconds per move (9 rounds).

8.2 Scoring System

8.2.1 Win: 3 points

8.2.2 Draw: 1 point

8.2.3 Loss: 0 points

8.3 Tie-Breaks

8.3.1 In the event of a tie for any position, the final rankings will be determined by applying the following tiebreak criteria, in the order listed below:

8.3.1.1 Direct Encounter

8.3.1.2 Buchholz Cut-1

8.3.1.3 Buchholz

8.3.1.4 Sonneborn-Berger

8.3.1.5 Number of wins with Black

8.4 Draw Agreements

8.4.1 No draw agreements are permitted before move 30.

8.4.2 If violated, the result of the game will be 0–0.

8.5 Fair Play

- 8.5.1 The tournament is conducted in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess.
- 8.5.2 Fair Play regulations will be strictly enforced throughout the event.
- 8.5.3 All players must arrive at least 1 hour before the scheduled start of their round to allow for Fair Play checks.
- 8.5.4 Electronic devices of any kind, including mobile phones, smart devices, and watches (digital or analogue), are strictly prohibited in the playing hall.
- 8.5.5 Players may be subjected to random Fair Play checks at any time during the event.
- 8.5.6 Dress code: Smart casual. Hoodies are not permitted.
- 8.5.7 Rowdy/intoxicated players may be expelled.
- 8.5.8 Alcohol/drugs are strictly prohibited.
- 8.5.9 Smoking is only allowed in designated areas.

8.6 Default Time

- 8.6.1 The default time for all rounds is 30 minutes.
- 8.6.2 There will be no default time for the blitz event.

8.7 Appeals

- 8.7.1 Appeals must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the game concerned.
- 8.7.2 An appeals fee of R500 is applicable to all appeals. The fee will be refunded for successful appeals.
- 8.7.3 The Appeals Committee's decision is final and binding.

9. COMMUNICATION

10. CONSENT FOR DATA SUBMISSION AND PUBLICATION:

- 10.1 The player, parent, or legal guardian hereby grants consent for the player's name, surname, gender, race, date of birth, CHESSA ID, and/or FIDE ID to be submitted to the relevant rating authorities (CHESSA and/or FIDE) for the purpose of tournament rating. These details may be displayed on the respective websites of the rating agencies.
- 10.2 Additionally, consent is granted for the publication of the player's details (name, surname, gender, race, date of birth, CHESSA ID, and/or FIDE ID) on www.chess-results.com for tournament pairings and administrative purposes.
- 10.3 The processing of this information is essential for the administration and operation of the tournament. **Players who do not provide consent for the above will be unable to participate in the event.**

11. PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

- 11.1 By registering for and participating in this tournament, players acknowledge and agree that photographs and video recordings may be taken during the event. These images and recordings may be used for promotional and communication purposes and may be published on official websites, social media platforms, and other digital or print media associated with the organisers and sponsors. Players who do not wish to appear in any published photos or videos must inform the organisers in writing prior to the start of the tournament.
